At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Township of Laketown, Allegan County, Michigan held at the Township Hall at 4338 Beeline Road, Holland, Michigan, on the 10th day of May, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. local time.

After certain other matters of business were concluded, the Clerk stated that the next order of business was the consideration of a proposed resolution to allow domestic animals under certain circumstances in certain parks in the Township. After discussion, the following resolution was offered by Dewey and supported by Stielstra.

DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN PARKS RESOLUTION 2006-08

WHEREAS, the Township's Park Regulation Ordinance, Ordinance No. 76, as amended, prohibits dogs, horses or domestic animals or pets in public parks in the Township, unless specifically allowed by Township Board resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to create an exception to that general prohibition;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Dogs which are maintained on a leash at all times, which leash is not longer than six feet, are allowed in the following public parks (as such term is defined in Ordinance No. 76, as amended):
 - Farview Park
 - Sanctuary Woods
 - Shore Acres
 - Huyser Farm
2. Horses are allowed in the following public parks on trails designated for use by horses:
 - Farview Park
 - Shore Acres
3. All resolutions in conflict in whole or in part with this Resolution are revoked to the extent of such conflict.
