PARK REGULATION AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP RESTATED PARK REGULATION ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 76; TO AMEND THE REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF PUBLIC PARKS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND GENERAL WELFARE OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, PARTICULARLY WITH REGARD TO PETS IN PUBLIC PARKS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKETOWN, COUNTY OF ALLEGAN AND STATE OF MICHIGAN HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment to Regulations - Pets in Parks. Section 3.N of the Laketown Township Restated Park Regulation Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 76, is amended to state in its entirety as follows.

- N. Pets. No dogs, horses or domestic animals or pets shall be allowed within any Public Park, unless specifically allowed by Township Board resolution.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Laketown Township, Allegan County, Michigan, on _____, 1998. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation with Laketown Township.
