**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at 7:00 p.m. on March 7, 2018 public hearings will be held to consider the following requests:

1. The special use request of GoBridges llc, owner or agent of property located at 6090 Blue Star Highway, that being tax parcel #0311-036-012-00. GoBridges llc. requests an amendment to its existing special use permit to allow for the construction of another building on this property.
2. The special use request of Laurel and Howard Bustle, owner or agent of property located at 4562 Lovers Lane, Holland, MI 49423, that being tax parcel #0311-460-012-00. Ms. and Mr. Bustle request a special use permit to split their parcel to create another building site.
3. The special use request of Mr. Scott Tucker, owner or agent of property located at 6255 Blue Star Highway, Saugatuck, MI 49453, that being tax parcel #0311-035-045-00. Mr. Tucker requests a special use permit to establish a contractor's yard with trucking/transport operations on this parcel.
4. The special use request of the Holland Board of Public Works to construct above ground utility equipment at or near the following locations: Property line of 4718 64th St and Copper Leaf Development; Roughly 450' south of 4544 64th St; 300' south of 4727 66th St; Property line of 6476 Spruce Ln and 4646 Beech St; Property line of 6489 Wildwood Rd and 4722 Wildwood Rd. The Holland Board of Public Works requests a special use permit to install 30' fiberglass poles for meter reading equipment at the above locations.

Please take notice that comments may be made in person at these public hearings, or by writing. Written comments will be accepted until 4:00 p.m. on the day of the hearings at the above address. Documents concerning these requests may be viewed at the Township Hall at the above address during normal business hours.

The Planning Commission, by ordinance and statute, has the right to deny, approve, or approve with conditions, the foregoing applications.
