

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON STREETLIGHT IMPROVEMENTS
AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL

142nd AVENUE STREETLIGHT SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

1. That the Township Board of the Township of Laketown, Allegan County, Michigan, has received petitions for and tentatively declared its intention to make the following improvements consisting of the acquisition, construction and operation of streetlight on 142nd Avenue in Laketown Township, Allegan County, Michigan.
2. That the above referenced special assessment roll is now on file in the office of the Township Clerk for public inspection. The roll may be examined at the Township office during regular business hours and also at the hearing referenced in paragraph 4 below.
3. That the Township Board has determined that the special assessment district against which a portion of the cost of said improvement is to be assessed shall be the parcels of land located in the Township of Laketown, Allegan County, Michigan, described specifically as follows:
Tax Parcel #'s: 0311-013-015-00, 0311-013-016-00, 0311-013-016-10, 0311-013-017-00, 0311-013-017-10, 0311-013-019-00, 0311-013-019-10, 0311-013-021-00, 0311-024-007-00, 0311-024-008-00, 0311-024-009-00, 0311-024-010-00, 0311-024-016-00, and 0311-024-017-00 or such other special assessment district or districts as shall be finally established by the Laketown Township Board.
4. That the Township Board will meet at the Laketown Township Hall, 4338 Beeline Road, Holland, Michigan, 49423 on the 13th day of June, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., local time, to review the above referenced special assessment roll and hear any objections and other matters related to that special assessment roll.
5. That as is provided in Michigan Act 64 of 1989, as amended, appearance and protest at the hearing (the "Hearing") referenced in paragraph 4 above is required in order to appeal the amount of any special assessment included in the above referenced special assessment roll to the State Tax Tribunal, if an appeal should be desired. An owner or party in interest, or his or her agent, may appear in person at the Hearing to protest a special assessment or may file his or her appearance or protest by letter delivered to the Township Clerk by the close of the Hearing and his or her personal appearance shall not be required. If the special assessment is protested as provided above, the owner or any party having an interest in the real property may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal or other court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days after the confirmation of the special assessment roll.
6. The Township of Laketown will provide necessary and reasonable auxiliary aids and services at this hearing, such as signors for hearing impaired persons and audio tapes of printed materials for visually-impaired persons, upon receipt of five days prior notice.
