**TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF: LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP AND ELECTORS RESIDING IN THE HAMILTON COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, COUNTY OF ALLEGAN, STATE OF MICHIGAN.**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that an Election will be held on Tuesday, May 3, 2016. The last day for receiving registrations for this Election will be Monday, April 4, 2016. Any qualified elector of the County of Allegan, Michigan, who is not already registered may register to vote at the office of their Township Clerk; the Office of the County Clerk; or other designated place for the Special Election. Persons registering after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 4, 2016, will not be eligible to vote at the election.

Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the Township Clerk or the office of the County Clerk or the Secretary of State Branch office or other state designated office will be open for registration. Registration may also be made at the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Human Services Department, the Department Community Health, Michigan Works and some offices of the Commission for the Blind and at the military recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the armed forces. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. Lastly, those already registered may update their voter registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

**PERSONS ENTITLED** to be registered voters must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the election (MCL 168.497).
