### **Working Hard for Our Priorities**

Senator Nesbitt is focused on upholding our West Michigan values and advancing solutions to help our families. Here are some of the highlights from the recent months:

#### **Reducing the Tax Burden**

With inflation hitting families hard and state government running a surplus, Senator Nesbitt introduced a significant tax relief plan. His plan would lower the personal income tax, provide a \$500 per child tax credit, and reduce Michigan's business tax rate to the lowest in the Midwest.

#### **Responsibly Fixing our Roads and Water Infrastructure**

The Senate recently passed legislation that would provide a \$1.6 billion investment toward fixing bridges in severe condition. This uses federal relief funding so it does not involve an additional burden on the state budget and would be on top of the regular road funding we are prioritizing in the budget. Additionally, we passed legislation that will upgrade water infrastructure.

#### **Balancing Budget, Growing our Economy**

Senator Nesbitt is continuing to fight for a balanced budget that pays down debt, responsibly funds our priorities, and leave money in the pockets of hardworking taxpayers. In doing so, we can continue to promote economic growth after the many difficulties faced in the last year.

#### **Fighting for Election Reform**

Not too long ago, Senator Nesbitt and his colleagues introduced a large package of bills to strengthen the integrity of our elections. This legislation includes requiring a photo ID to vote, strong signature verification requirements, cleaning up the qualified voter file, and provisions to ensure the openness and transparency of election audits, counting, and canvassing activities. Additionally, they are also working on bills to allow more flexibility and time for our clerks to process ballots more efficiently so that Michigan can quickly report accurate results following an election.
