PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that an Election will be held on Tuesday, May 8, 2018. The last day for receiving registrations for this Election will be Monday, April 9, 2018. Persons residing in said Township registering after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 9, 2018, will not be eligible to vote at the election. Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the Township Clerk or the office of the County Clerk or the Secretary of State branch office or other state designated office will be open for registration. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. A person who registers to vote by mail is required to vote in person unless they have satisfied identification requirements with the local clerk or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped. Only persons who have registered as electors with the Township Clerk or with the County Clerk or through registration at a Secretary of State branch office or other state designated office or by using an official mail registration application, are registered electors of said City/Township.

PERSONS ENTITLED to be registered voters in said City/Township must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the General Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the election (MCL 168.497).

FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS IN SAID CITY OR TOWNSHIP. YOU MAY REGISTER AT THE OFFICE OF YOUR LOCAL CLERK OR THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK OR THE SECRETARY OF STATE BRANCH OFFICE OR OTHER STATE DESIGNATED OFFICE OR BY OFFICIAL MAIL REGISTRATION. PERSONS REGISTERING TO VOTE AFTER 5:00 P.M. ON APRIL 9, 2018 WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE MAY 8, 2018 ELECTION.

CITY PROPOSALS**

CITY OF HOLLAND HOLLAND COMMUNITY SWIMMING POOL MILLAGE PROPOSITION – RENEWAL/ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZATION (This millage would renew the previously authorized 1.0 mill levy, which expires on December 31, 2018, for the operation of the Holland Community Aquatic Center.) Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property (both homestead and non-homestead) in the Holland Area Community Swimming Pool Authority (whose geographic boundaries are coterminous with those of the Holland School District) be increased to the amount of 1 mills (\$1.00 on each \$1,000) on taxable value for a period of five (5) years, 2019 through 2023, inclusive, to provide funds to enable the Authority to own, operate, and maintain a community swimming pool and shall the Authority be authorized to levy said tax? If this millage is approved and levied, it is estimated that it will result in a revenue of \$1,285,072 being collected by the Authority in the 2019 calendar year.
