

**NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION  
FOR THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION  
COUNTY OF ALLEGAN IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN**

**TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP, ALLEGAN, COUNTY.**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that an Election will be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. The last day for receiving registrations for this Election will be Tuesday, October 9, 2018. Persons residing in said Township registering after 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, will not be eligible to vote at the election. Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the Township Clerk or the office of the County Clerk or the Secretary of State Branch office or other state designated office will be open for registration. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. A person who registers to vote by mail is required to vote in person unless he/she has satisfied identification requirements with the local clerk or is at least 60 years of age or is handicapped. Only persons who have registered as electors with the Township Clerk or with the County Clerk or through registration at a Secretary of State branch office or other state designated office or by using an official mail registration application, are registered electors of said Township. Lastly, those already registered may update their voter registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

**PERSONS ENTITLED** to be registered voters in said Township must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the General Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the election (MCL 168.497).

PERSONS REGISTERING TO VOTE AFTER 5:00 P.M. ON OCTOBER 9, 2018 WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION.**

**OTTAWA AREA INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL.** Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Ottawa Area Intermediate School District, Michigan, be increased by 0.9 mill (\$0.9 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2019 to 2028, inclusive, to provide operating funds to enhance other state and local funding for local school district operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2019 is approximately \$11,200,000, which funds will be disbursed as required by statute to: Allendale Public Schools, Coopersville Area Public Schools, Grand Haven Area Public Schools, Hamilton Community Schools, School District of the City of Holland, Hudsonville Public Schools, Jenison Public Schools, Saugatuck Public Schools, Spring Lake Public Schools, West Ottawa Public Schools, Zeeland Public Schools, Black River Public School, Eagle Crest Charter Academy, Icademy Global, Innocademy, Vanderbilt Charter Academy, Walden Green Montessori, West Michigan Academy of Arts and Academics, and Ottawa Area Intermediate School District?
