

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE
LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on the 1st day of September, 2021, a public hearing will be held by the Laketown Township Planning Commission at the Laketown Township Office, 4338 Beeline Road, Holland, Michigan (Telephone: 616-335-3050), at 7:00 p.m. local time, to hear and consider proposed amendments to the text of the Laketown Township Zoning Ordinance to amend certain sections of the Zoning Ordinance.

The proposed amendments will:

Establish the R-1.5 Rural Estate District and make related changes throughout the Zoning Ordinance;

Update language regarding mobile homes and signage;

Require non-motorized pathways to be included with certain developments;

Establish the maximum occupancy of dwelling units; and

Establish parking requirements for dwellings.

The tentative text of the proposed amendments to the Laketown Township Zoning Ordinance may be examined by any person at the Township Office at 4338 Beeline Road, Holland, Michigan (Telephone: 616-335-3050), on any day of the week except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Written comments concerning the tentative text of the proposed amendments will be received at the Township Office during those same hours.

Laketown Township will provide necessary and reasonable auxiliary aids and services at this hearing, such as signers for hearing-impaired persons and audiotapes of printed materials for visually impaired persons, upon receipt of five days prior notice.
